Dear Superintendent Pearson and Principal Davidian

As a school psychologist with 40 years experience in assessment including assessment of dangerousness in students charged with attempted murder I find the way you handled your concern and events regarding the statements of Mr. Lohr greatly disappointing. It would appear that he was encouraged to make a comment, a comment he found important and meaningful, to his lower class men as a graduating student. It appears that he changed his script after his script was read by your supervisor for some sort of approval. His comments about gender were neither malicious nor vicious. Infact they reflect the opinion of a significant number of his countryman. They were not inappropriate. With the exception of various genetic mutations (which are exceptionally rare,) there are only two sex chromosome patterns, xy and xx. His comments as reported in 4 different media were simply that there are only two sexes and nothing inbetween. Had you simply let it go and disciplined him for not stating his approved comments that might have been the extent of it. The severity of his misbehaviour might merit a single day suspension in the vast majority of school systems in North America.

You created a fire storm of anger by preventing him from participating in his graduation. A once in a life event. This entire fire storm is on you and your lack of professionalism and incompetence in your decision about his punishment. Your incompetence is further demonstrated in making a silly decision to cancel the graduation and then not cancel it. In virtually no region that I know of, would his comments have been considered as meriting cancellation of his participation in his graduation. Your over reaction was extreme. Did Mr. Lohr violate any ones human rights? Did a transitioning or Trans student complain to you about the comments. IF so did either of you set up a mediation to solve the conflict or discomfort caused by Mr. Lohr's comments. A caring professional educator with appropriate human resources training would have set up a solution meeting between a trans student and Mr. Lohr, if there were concerns. It seems likely there were none. So why the over reaction for an event that really had no consequences except for those caused by the decisions of the Principal and perhaps the Superintendent.

If as in 99 percent of schools in the United States you enforce the importance of free speech as a right , with little attention to the responsibility of free speech You set up Mr. Lohr for exactly what happened to him. An effective and competent leader or Principal , in talking to his graduating students about their comments to lower class man would have "primed them" that comments on controversial subjects will be reviewed with an eye to ensure they are not provocative or hatefull or insulting. It is almost certain that no one did that.

Both you gentelman are responsible for the nation wide firestorm that this event caused. The student is likely less than 5 percent responsible and you two are more then 95 percent responsible. Incompetance such as this is shameful.
